God keeps me from evil. He protects me when I walk in and when I walk out. He is with me, so I don't need to be afraid. (Psalm 121:5-8)

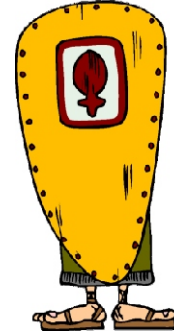
God won't allow my foot to slip or stumble. He keeps me. He stays up all night watching over me. (Psalm 121:5-8)

Jesus is in me, and He's greater than the devil who is in the world! My God protects me, so I don't need to be afraid of the devil or of the dangers he may try to put in my path. (1 John 4:4)

Your angels keep me safe. They hold me in their hands, and keep me safe in everything I do. They set up camp around me and deliver me out of any trouble. (Psalm 34:7)



No sickness, accident, or disaster can come near me. You keep me and guard me, because I put my trust in you, Lord. (Psalm 91:10)

God is my strong tower. He keeps me safe from harm. His angels are around me, keeping me out of danger. (Psalm 61:3-4)

Trouble can't come near me. No evil can harm me or my family, because God keeps us safe from all harm. No attack that satan brings against us can work. (Isaiah 54:17)

Your angels go with me everywhere I go, keeping me safe. I won't get into danger, because I'm walking with God. I will fear no evil, for God is with me. (Psalm 34:7, Psalm 23:4)

God is with me, and He keeps me everywhere I go. (Genesis 28:15)

I am on God's side! He is greater than the devil and anything he tries to throw my way. (1 John 4:4)
